

## Protected Disclosures Acts 2014-2022

### Annual Report 2024

Under Section 22 of the Protected Disclosures Act 2014 (amended in 2022) public bodies are required to prepare a report setting out the number of protected disclosures made to it in the course of the immediately preceding year and certain other information relating to any such protected disclosures.

This report under Section 22 of the Protected Disclosures Act covers the period from 1 January 2024 to 31 December 2024. **No disclosures were made to the National Museum of Ireland in that period.** 

Section 22 of the Act requires each public body to publish an annual report not later than 1 March in each year, setting out the following information to the Minister in respect of the immediately preceding year
