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## DIRECTOR'S INTRODUCTION

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Minister John O' Donoghue's approval in principal of the Central Block facility has to be the most significant event of 2004 for the future of the National Museum of Ireland - Decorative Arts & History, at Collins Barracks. Planning permission was also secured for additional building works to be built at right angles to the North Block of Clarke Square (Collins Barracks) for the accommodation of our planned Military History exhibition. A contractor was appointed for the restoration of the Riding School (Collins Barracks) which is to become a temporary exhibition gallery. Consultants were commissioned to carry out a development plan at Natural History, Merrion St and Archaeology & History at Kildare St. 2004 also saw the completion of the courtyard at the National Museum of Ireland - Country Life. This will provide additional space for the education department and the restaurant.

The main exhibition of the year was '*What's In Store?*' which seeks to make publicly accessible more than 12,000 objects in the Art & Industrial collections - this includes the *entire* national collections of glass, silver, pewter, brass, enamel, ceramics and Asian applied art.

Collins Barracks also saw an exhibition of *Toy Stories* - a look at toys and games mainly of the nineteenth century, *Influence - Contemporary Metals and Jewellery* which celebrated the tenth anniversary of the National College of Art and Design annual silverware design com-

petition. *Inspirational Awakening - Irish Contemporary Glass*, a display of current glass instigated by the Glass Society of Ireland was launched with special acknowledgement of the overall contribution to the National Museum by Mrs Mary Boydell, who recently presented her collection of glass to the National Collection (it is on display in '*What's in Store?*').

The National Museum of Ireland - Country Life put on displays of *Notice to Quit: Scenes of Eviction - Ireland 1886-1890, Down Memory Lane - Childhood in the 1950s* and appropriately, a special display of the *Mias Tighearnáin*, the medieval reliquary associated with Errew, Crossmolina, Co. Mayo.

The National Museum of Ireland - Archaeology & History was honoured to show a collection of the memorabilia of W. T. Cosgrave, the first President of the Executive Council of the Free State. These were presented by his son Liam Cosgrave, the former Taoiseach and are most notable for the beautiful set of silver goblets presented on the President's return to Dublin when Ireland joined the League of Nations in 1924. 2004 also witnessed the exhibition of Viking age ships' timbers and a collection of Cypriot antiquities. Restoration work was carried out on the casts of the High Crosses last displayed in 1976. Notable acquisitions included three Bowl Food Vessels from Liscooley, Co. Donegal; the enamelled lid of a Roman seal box from Drumanagh, Co. Dublin; architectural stonework from

Co. Galway and Co. Roscommon and a stone lamp from Inishbofin, Co. Galway.

Minister John O'Donoghue launched *A Policy Framework for Education, Community Outreach*. A two-day seminar was organised on Irish involvement in the First World War and at the National Museum of Ireland - Country Life, Castlebar the Education Department oversaw the construction of a block-wheeled cart. A *Sandford Award* for Heritage Education from the Heritage Education Trust was awarded to the National Museum of Ireland - Country Life in recognition of "quality education" delivered at Turlough Park House.

The National Museum of Ireland - Natural History received a *Museum of the Year Award* for Best Access and Outreach for a unique collaboration with University College Dublin with a project entitled Collections-based Biology in Dublin (CoBiD). Block 14 at Collins Barracks received a *Museum of the Year Award* for Best Collections Care. 2004 also saw the publication of a Customer Charter for the National Museum which sets out the standard of service people are entitled to expect. December 2004 saw the last meeting of the Caretaker Board and the appointment of the Statutory Board under

the terms of the National Cultural Institutions Act, 1997 was announced as the year drew to a close. I cannot let the record of 2004 pass without paying tribute to the contribution of the Caretaker Board and its indefatigable Chairperson, Barbara Nugent who was particularly supportive of the Museum's buildings acquisition and development at Collins Barracks, Dublin and Turlough Park House, Castlebar. The chairperson's support for our planned Phase II development at Collins Barracks is especially appreciated as is the time and energy given by her other colleagues, most importantly Sean P. Cromien over the past decade on both the Interim and Caretaker Boards.

In January, we were sad to lose our longest serving colleague, Dermot O' Sullivan, R.I.P. a native of Tahilla, Sneem, Co. Kerry who worked as a technical assistant mainly in the Irish Folklife Division and served for a long time at our Daingean, Co. Offaly stores. Dermot a keen gaelic football fan, with an infectious sense of humour was a generous and popular member of staff. He had a sense of can-do practicality and gifted hand skills which he lavished upon the collections and stores in his care. He worked at the Museum for thirty-five years. Ar dheis Dé go raibh a anam dilis.

## ART AND INDUSTRY

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The Division is responsible for over a quarter of a million artefacts reflecting Irish economic, social, industrial, political and military history over the last three centuries. In addition the staff care for collections of Irish, European and Oriental decorative arts, which give an understanding of oriental design and culture as they relate to Ireland.

2004 was an extremely busy and productive one for the Division, especially in the area of exhibitions. Work on the Military History exhibition continued with a large body of research carried out during the year. Three temporary exhibitions were mounted and the process of making the reserve collections permanently accessible to the public culminated in the '*What's in Store?*' initiative, a facility which opened to the public in November in the East Block of Collins Barracks with 12,000 objects exhibited comprising of metalwork, scientific instruments, glass, oriental and ceramics collections. The other temporary exhibitions mounted included *Influence - Contemporary Metals and Jewellery* (in cooperation with N.C.A.D); *Inspirational Awakening - Irish Contemporary Glass; Toy Stories* and *W. T. Cosgrave Memorabilia* which was exhibited at the National Museum of Ireland - Archaeology & History.

Important purchases during the year included additions to the contemporary collections of furniture, jewellery, glass and ceramics which were all made in conjunction with the Crafts Council of Ireland. Additions were also made to the period furniture collection including a Hicks display cabinet c.1900 and a mahogany chest of drawers by Henry Owens, Dublin c.1830. Other purchases included three

pieces of glass from the Gerald Goldberg Collection; an overmantel mirror, by Cornelius Callaghan, Dublin, c.1830; a mirror, by James del Vecchio, Dublin, c.1830; a barometer by Bennett, Cork, c.1840 and a flintlock pistol by Goggin, Dublin, c.1750.

Numerous donations were received throughout the year, especially for the textile, glass and historical collections. Items included garments by Irish designers, from the late Mrs Mairin Lynch; an Edwardian wedding dress; Mary Boydell collection of 19th century Dublin glass; silver brooch and silver pendant, donated by Sean Kenna, Leixlip; 1950s evening cloak by Nicholas O'Dwyer, Suffolk Street; enamel plaque, by Phoebe Traquair, 1907; 20 pieces of glass from Waterford glass which was part of its 2004 catalogue and Harry Boland's pistol, c.1920.

The staff of the Division facilitated a great number of researchers and answered a wide variety of enquiries across the full range of the collections. They also contributed to radio and television programmes and published short articles on their respective subjects and collections. With regard to larger publications, the Silver Catalogue was well advanced. Numerous lectures, talks and guided tours were given as the Division worked with the Education Department and Marketing Department to promote the collections.

In the area of collections care, the year ended on a very positive note with the final evacuation of Kil-dare Street, the finalisation of the movement of the furniture collection to the new facility at Block 14, Collins Barracks and the ongoing cataloguing of the philatelic, military and Eileen Gray collections.

## EALAÍON AGUS TIONSCAL

Tá cúram ar an Roinn i leith breis is ceathrú milliún déantán a léirionn stair eacnamaíoch, shóisialta, tionsclaioch, pholaitiúil agus mhileata na hÉireann le trí chéad bliain anuas. Ina theannta sin tugann an fhoireann aire do na bailiúcháin d'ealaíona maisiúla Éireannacha, Eorpacha, agus Oirthearacha a thugann léargas ar dhearadh agus ar chultúr an Oirthir mar a bhaineann siad le hÉirinn.

Bliain ghnóthach bhisiúil ab ea 2004 don Roinn, i dtaca le taispeántais go háirithe. Lean an obair ar an taispeántas Stair Mhileata agus rinneadh lear mór taighde i gcaitheamh na bliana. Bhí trí thaispeántas sealadach ann agus ba é an tionscnamh 'Cad atá sa Stór?' an toradh ar iarracht chun na bailiúcháin chúlchiste a chur ar fail go buan don phobal. Osclaiodh an tsaoráid seo don phobal i Samhain i mbloc Thoir Dhún Uí Choileáin agus tá 12,000 déantán ar taispeánt ann lena n-áirítear miotalóireacht, gléasanna eolaíocha, gloine, agus na bailiúcháin oirthearacha agus ceirmeacha. Ar na taispeántais eile a bhí againn bhí Influence - Contemporary Metals and Jewellery (i gcomhar le an gColáiste Náisiúnta Ealaíne agus Dearaidh); Inspirational Awakening - Irish Contemporary Glass; Scéalta Bréagáin agus Earrai Cuimhneacháin de chuid Liam Mac Coscar a cuireadh ar taispeánt ag Ard-Mhúsaem na hÉireann - Seandálaíocht & Stair.

Ar na déantáin tábhachtacha a ceannaiodh i gcaitheamh na bliana bhí breisíochtaí ar na bailiúcháin chomhaimseartha troscán, seodra, gloine agus ceirmeach a rinneadh i gcomhar le Comhairle Ceardaiochta na hÉireann. Ceannaiodh breisíochtaí chomh maith ar an mbailliúchán troscáin seanré lena n-áirítear caibinéad taispeántais le Hicks c.1900 agus cófá tarraiceán mahagaine le Henry Owens, Baile Átha Cliath c.1830. Anuas orthu siúd ceannaiodh trí mhír ghloine ó Bhailiúchán Gerald Goldberg; scáthán

formhatail, le Cornelius Callaghan, Baile Átha Cliath, c.1830; scáthán, le James de Vecchio, Baile Átha Cliath, c.1830; baraiméadar le Bennett, Cork, c.1840 agus pios-tal cloch thine le Goggin, Baile Átha Cliath, c.1750.

Fuarthas bronntanais iomadúla i rith na bliana, go háirithe do na bailiúcháin teicstíle, ghloine agus stáiriúla. Ar na mireanna seo bhí éadaí le dearthóirí Éireannacha, ó Mháirín, Bean Uí Loingsigh, nach maireann; gúna bainise Eadbhardach; bailiúchán Mary Boydell de ghloine Bhaile Átha Cliath ón 19ú haois; bróiste airgid agus cloigín airgid, a fuarthas ó Sean Kenna, Léim an Bhradáin; clóca feascair ó Nicholas O'Dwyer, Sráid Suffolk; pláic cruain, le Phoebe Traquair, 1907; 20 mhír gloine ó Ghloine Phort Láirge a bhí mar chuid dá gcatalóg 2004 agus piostal Harry Boland, c.1920.

D'éascaigh foireann na Roinne uimhir mhór taighdeoirí agus d'fhreagair siad ceisteanna éagsúla maidir le raon iomlán na mbailliúchán. Ghlac siad páirt i gcláir raidió agus teilifise chomh maith agus d'fhoilsigh ailt ghairide i dtaobh a n-ábhar agus a mbailliúchán faoi seach. Maidir leis na foilseacháin mhóra, tá an obair ar Chatalóg an Airgid go maith chun cinn. Tugadh léachtaí agus cainteanna iomadúla mar aon le turais threoraithe agus d'oibrigh an Roinn leis an Roinn Oideachais agus an Roinn Margaiochta chun na bailiúcháin a chur chun cinn.

Maidir le cúram na mbailliúchán, tháinig an bhliain chun críche ar nota an-dearfach nuair a tógadh na mireanna deireanacha as Sráid Chill Dara. Criochnaiodh aistriú an bhailiúchán troscáin go dtí an áis nua ag Bloc 14, Dún Uí Choileáin agus tá an obair ar siúl i gcoinéar ar an mbailliúchán stampaí, ar an mbailliúchán míleata agus ar bhailiúchán Eileen Gray.

## IRISH ANTIQUITIES

The Division is responsible for the archaeological heritage of Ireland. In addition to managing substantial collections of Ethnographical, Classical and Egyptian material the staff control and manage over two million archaeological objects.

The annual register stands at 206 objects in addition to two collections of metal detected objects (mainly coins but including Viking silver and medieval artefacts) which were recovered by the Gardaí. Also acquired was an old collection of over four hundred objects, mainly prehistoric in date, from Co. Sligo. Notable acquisitions included three Bowl Food Vessels from Liscooly, Co. Donegal; an enamelled lid of a Roman seal box from Drumanagh, Co. Dublin; architectural stonework from Ballynahinch, Co. Galway and Cleaboy, Co. Roscommon and a stone lamp from St. Colman's monastery, Inishbofin, Co. Galway.

In response to reported accidental discoveries of archaeological objects and in connection with finds from archaeological excavations, fieldwork was undertaken in counties Carlow, Cavan, Cork, Donegal, Dublin, Galway, Kilkenny, Laois, Louth, Limerick, Longford, Mayo, Meath, Offaly, Roscommon, Tipperary, Waterford, Westmeath and Wexford.

Development-related archaeological activity has continued at a high volume and there was continuing liaison with licensees, the Department of the Environment, Heritage and Local Government, and others in relation

to excavation methodologies. Over 2,200 licences of various types were processed. There was considerable interaction with archaeologists employed by the National Roads Authority in relation to road schemes all over the country. Staff also participated in the Bord na Móna Liaison Committee which discussed recent bog finds and survey.

Consultation took place with the Chief State Solicitor's Office concerning various legal files and assistance was provided to the Art and Antiques Unit, National Bureau of Criminal Investigation, An Garda Síochána in relation to alleged breaches of the National Monuments Act. Advice was tendered to the Department of Arts, Sport and Tourism concerning an amendment to the National Monuments Acts. There was also close liaison with the Underwater Archaeological Unit, Department of the Environment, Heritage and Local Government on matters concerning endangered historic wrecks including Spanish Armada wrecks, crannógs sites, and maritime salvage. Work was also undertaken in relation to the Bantry longboat, the *Asgard* and looted cannon from Tramore Bay, Co. Waterford. The Museum continued to be represented on the monthly Excavation Licence Interview Board.

The Tritton Collection of 420 archaeological objects mainly from the Mullaghmore area of Co. Sligo was documented fully. An inventory of divisional objects in the Inchicore store was completed. An important series of colour transparencies was archived and the collection of ordnance survey maps were re-boxed and shelved.

Advice was provided to the Cork Public Museum, Carlow County Museum, Clare County Museum, Tipperary South Riding Museum, and the Louth County Museum. Staff had dealings with the Duncannon Fort Museum and there were visits to Tipperary South Riding Museum and Cashel Folk Village Museum to investigate reports of archaeological discoveries. Staff also officially inspected Designated Museums for Co. Cavan and Co. Louth. Advice was provided to the Director and to the Department of Arts, Sport and Tourism concerning the proposed operation of the Heritage Council's proposed Museum Standards and Accreditation Scheme in relation to Designated Museums. Staff attended meetings of the Designated Museums Liaison Committee.

Meetings took place with the National Museums of Scotland to advise on the relationship of the National Museum of Ireland with Designated County Museums; possible future joint work on EU projects; facilitation by the NMI of an NMS research project and repatriation of an Irish antiquity.

A consultant ethnographer was contracted to undertake identification of objects in the Ethnographical Collection. The formulation of an exit strategy from the storage facilities in Daingean was progressed. The Irish Antiquities Laboratory and surrounding storerooms were upgraded. Student Interns worked on numbering and labelling two collections of antiquities. Work was carried out

documenting and repacking dendrochronology and other samples from the Dublin excavations. Excavation material abroad was sourced and documented and the work of listing is almost finalised.

Progress was made on the preparation of the Fishamble Street stratigraphical report as part of the Dublin Excavation Post Excavation Project. Progress was also made on specialist reports dealing with bone, antler, and ivory objects; leather scabbards and sheaths; pottery; wooden vessels; animal bones and amber.

The purpose of the Unpublished Burials Project is to publish all burials investigated over the years by museum staff. The osteology reports for the project were completed and the results of the radiocarbon dating programme received. A report was sent to the Heritage Council which part funded the project.

The Bog Bodies Project is concerned with publishing three recent finds of bog bodies from Derrycashel, Co. Roscommon, Old Croghan, Co. Offaly and Clonycavan, Co. Meath. The project was progressed by curatorial staff of the Division, in co-operation with the Conservation Department. The BBC was selected to produce a TV documentary on the project. A panel of experts was assembled to undertake further excavation and analysis of the bodies. Excavation took place at the find-spot of the Old Croghan body.

The Museum benefited from significant EU funding (through the Library Council of Ireland) for practical implementation of 3-D technology - laser scanning and imaging of an initial 15 objects from the collection and the production of images for both web site and research usage. A poster produced by the Irish Antiquities Division (texts) and Kestrel 3D Ltd. (graphics) was presented at the European Cultural Digitisation Conference, Dublin Castle.

The Irish Antiquities Division participated in a joint Crannóg research project with the Department of Archaeology, UCD, and the Underwater Unit, National Monument Service (Coolure Demesne Crannóg, Lough Derravaragh) and with the Discovery Programme (crannógs in Lough Kinale). Fieldwork was undertaken in counties Westmeath and Longford. This was partly funded by the Heritage Council to whom a report was submitted.

As Part of the Gold Research Project fieldwork was undertaken in Co. Down and a meeting of the group was held at the University of Leeds. A catalogue of the Museum's holdings of Roman and Byzantine antiquities is being compiled by Dr. Lynda Mulvin, Department of Art History, UCD.

Staff attended various conferences and courses during the year. Nessa O'Connor participated in a Leaders for Tomorrow programme in Boston and at the John F. Kennedy School of Government in Harvard during October and November.

A seminar was also held in the Museum on the work of the institution attended by officials of the Heritage Council and Heritage Officers from around the country. A seminar on underwater archaeology was held in memory of the late Professor Bob Farrell. Staff also gave lectures to the Co. Westmeath branch of an Taisce; the Douglas Hyde Summer School; UCD Certificate Course in Archaeology; the Ulster Archaeological Society; a UCC seminar on unpublished excavations; an M.A. seminar in UCC on the archaeological role of the National Museum of Ireland; the internal series for Museum attendants and an in-house presentation on the results of EU projects on 3D technology in archaeological museums.

Divisional staff represent the Museum on the National Committee for Archaeology (Royal Irish Academy), Bord na Móna Liaison Group, Designated Museums Liaison Committee, the Council of the Discovery Programme, the Prehistoric Gold Research Group, Excavation Licence Interview Board and the Selection Committee re: Section 1003, Taxes Consolidation Act.

A large number of researchers were facilitated in the Division's archive room and reserve collections. Transition year students and postgraduate Student Interns gained work experience in the Division during the year.

## IRISH FOLKLIFE

The Division houses the national collection of objects representing Irish traditional life, dating principally to the period 1850 to 1950.

Two exhibitions were mounted in the temporary exhibition gallery opened in 2003. *Notice to Quit Scenes of Eviction - Ireland 1886-1890* consisted of a display of photographs from the National Library of Ireland on the subject of 19th century evictions, complemented by a selection of artefacts from the Division's collections. The purchase of a number of exhibition cases during the year enabled the Division to prepare a more comprehensive exhibition from its own holding entitled *Down Memory Lane - Childhood in the 1950s*. A medieval

mugs and a series of boats including a Moy cot and a Moy cobble. Fieldwork was carried out in relation to traditions associated with currach and boat-making, dressmaking and paper milling.

Curators were involved in promoting the Museum's activities through a series of gallery talks, lectures to outside bodies and interviews on national and local radio and television. In addition to RTÉ and Raidió na Gaeltachta, interviews were broadcast on local radio stations in Mayo, Sligo, Donegal, Galway, Limerick and Clare. Curators represent the Museum on a number of external bodies including the Mayo County Heritage Forum and the Agricultural History Society.

A MEDIEVAL RELIQUARY KNOWN AS THE MIAS TIGHEARNÁIN (ST. TIERNAN'S DISH), ASSOCIATED WITH ERREW, CO. MAYO AND ACQUIRED BY THE MUSEUM FROM A PRIVATE COLLECTION IN SCOTLAND IN 1999 WAS PUT ON TEMPORARY DISPLAY. THE NATIONAL MUSEUM OF IRELAND - COUNTRY LIFE WAS SHOWCASED INTERNATIONALLY THROUGH AN EXHIBITION ENTITLED *CURACHS*, ONE OF A NUMBER OF EXHIBITIONS MOUNTED IN THE SLOVENE ETHNOGRAPHIC MUSEUM, LJUBLJANA.

reliquary known as the *Mias Tighearnáin* (St. Tiernan's Dish), associated with Errew, Co. Mayo and acquired by the Museum from a private collection in Scotland in 1999 was put on temporary display. The National Museum of Ireland - Country Life was showcased internationally through an exhibition entitled *Curachs*, one of a number of exhibitions mounted in the Slovene Ethnographic Museum, Ljubljana.

Work continued on formulating an acquisitions policy for the Division. During the year some 1,100 objects were acquired, the most significant being an important collection of over 100 spongeware and transfer-printed

Further work on the digitisation of the Divisions archival holdings of 35mm slides was undertaken as well as on the proposed re-housing of the Divisional archives. Work began on the text of a guidebook to the National Museum of Ireland - Country Life and assistance was also provided towards the publication of a number of books on boat- and currach making.

Paul Doyle, Manager/Keeper was transferred to Dublin during the year and Sharon Quinn and Michael Harte were appointed as Technical Assistant and Caretaker respectively to look after the reserve collections in Daingean, Co. Offaly.

### NATURAL HISTORY

The Division cares for the Museum collections in the disciplines of zoology and geology, which number approximately two million specimens.

During the year a catalogue on the collection of spirit-preserved Mollusca was completed, while work on the curation of the BioMar collection of echinoderms revealed a number of interesting species. A rare example of a crustacean (the copepod *Dactylopusioides macrolabris*) was discovered from Lough Hyne, West Cork. The first instalment of the dry mollusc collections were relocated to Beggars Bush. A number of survey projects carried out by subject specialists on the collections of dry bryozoans, non-passerine birds, mammals bones and bird bones resulted in listings of these collections and re-housing of the bird bone collections.

Work continued on the entomological collections with material in the Spirit Collection being rebottled where necessary and new material added. The opportunity was also taken to incorporate relevant material from store-boxes which the Museum had acquired over the last hundred years as well as specimens recently determined by leading authorities on these groups.

A major section of the Irish butterfly collection was staged and re-housed. A new collection of Irish gall-wasps (Cynipidae) was established while work continued on sorting out the nomenclature of the vast ichneumonid collection and the setting up of the new gall-mite and gall-midge collections. A large number of insects were named, staged, labelled and incorporated into the main scientific collections

A small amount of organisation of vertebrate fossil collections took place and the fossil amphibian and reptile collections were moved to new drawers with the assistance of volunteers. Fifty game heads were cleaned and restored by a Dutch taxidermist as part of an annual programme of cleaning and repairing exhibits.

A Pest Monitoring programme was established in Natural History and the Beggars Bush storage building. Data collected to monitor the environmental conditions in Beggars Bush was analysed to establish the suitability of several rooms to house the natural history collections.

A brief was prepared to assist the OPW in preparation of a development and control plan for the Natural History

DURING THE YEAR A CATALOGUE ON THE COLLECTION OF SPIRIT-PRESERVED MOLLUSCA WAS COMPLETED, WHILE WORK ON THE CURATION OF THE BIO-MAR COLLECTION OF ECHINODERMS REVEALED A NUMBER OF INTERESTING SPECIES. building. A plan was prepared to replace all light units in the exhibition areas in line with recommendations from a conservation lighting survey.

Scientific specimens donated by researchers included collections of insects, parasitic worms, crustaceans, fish, monkey skulls, two long-eared owls, a fallow deer and an antelope. New registrations were given to specimens already in the collections that were acquired prior to 1877 when numbering was first introduced.

Research continued on the Irish insect fauna, including the preparation and publication of checklists on several major groups viz. the true bugs with particular emphasis on the Heteroptera (Hemiptera), the two-winged flies (Diptera) parasitic wasps. The research project on Ancient DNA in Irish Mammals led by staff in the Department of Genetics, Trinity College, Dublin continued as did work on Jurassic ichthyosaurs and marine crocodiles led by students in the Department of Zoology, University College Dublin. The CoBiD (Collections-based Biology in Dublin) project initiated in 2003 involving a partnership between the Museum and the Department of Zoology, UCD expanded during the year and developed a website

to host catalogues of museum specimens and to act as a teaching resource.

Exhibitions were improved with the replacement of all the protective covers on the insect display cases. Mounts were prepared for new antelopes and stands were installed to support Archaeopteryx fossil casts. Two cases dedicated to Charles Darwin were put on display to mark Darwin Day (12th February).

Staff contributed to a number of in-house events, to television and radio programmes, gave numerous lectures and took part in *Science Week*. Staff also assisted in a course entitled "the Dead Zoo: behind the scenes at the Natural History Museum" run in conjunction with the Adult Education Department, UCD as part of the CoBiD partnership. This resulted in a number of volunteers assisting in catalogue projects. The Natural Sciences Collections Association (NatSCA) was hosted by the Museum. This conference included tours of the Museum, stores and the conservation building at Collins Barracks. A major public lecture was held during the year entitled "The Dinosaurs of the Gobi Desert", delivered by Dr Mark Norell of the American Museum of Natural History, New York.

## CONSERVATION

3 2

The primary role of conservation is to stabilise the condition of objects thereby safeguarding them for the future. This is achieved by ensuring that all objects are kept in the correct storage environment (preventive conservation) and by reversing deterioration that has already occurred by means of painstaking laboratory work (remedial conservation).

A number of exhibitions opened during the year, many of which involved a heavy workload for the Conservation Department. These exhibitions included *Influence - Contemporary Metals and Jewellery*, *Toy Stories* and *Down Memory Lane - Childhood in the 1950s*. Work also continued on the Military History exhibition.

By far the largest project undertaken in 2004 was for 'What's in Store?'. This project involved the cleaning of some 12,000 objects from the Art and Industry collections. The entire metalwork, oriental and glass collections were included in this work. The preparation of objects was particularly problematic as a result of the extreme quantities of dirt with which the items were covered, as a consequence of their former storage in the Art and Industry crypt at Kildare Street. In total, in excess of 6 person years were spent on preparing material for inclusion in the facility.

Another major undertaking was the conservation of plaster replica high crosses, in preparation for inclusion in the Irish Pavilion at Expo 2005 at Nagoya, Japan. These crosses, up to 6.5m in height, were in poor condition as a result of inadequate storage. Substantial progress was made on the research into the two bog bodies found in 2003, with the National Museum's Bog Bodies Project, which sought to gain as much information as possible about the lives and deaths of the individuals concerned.

This work became a major international research project, carried out in conjunction with the BBC who followed proceedings with a view to making a major documentary.

Other projects to systematically upgrade the condition of entire collections continued. Work on the Period Furniture collection carried on and has made a huge impact on the condition of this collection. Other collections looked at in this way included the Blaschka Glass in Natural History, the Ceramics and Glass collections in Art and Industry and the Straw and Wicker collection in the Irish Folklife Division. Work in the Waterlogged Wood Centre at Lanesborough, Co. Roscommon continued to clear the 60-year backlog of waterlogged wood conservation, with excellent results.

The largest project connected with preventive conservation in 2004, was the transfer of material from the Gymnasium at Collins Barracks, and the Inchicore store, to the new Block 14 store at Collins Barracks. Objects transferred included the entire period furniture collection and many large items from across the Museum. Objects from Inchicore were systematically cleaned, after 20 years in poor storage, to avoid the spread of dirt into the new facility. The Block 14 store won the *2004 Museum of the Year Award* for Best Collections Care. New storage furniture was purchased for the National Museum of Ireland - Natural History, and a flag chest was purchased for inclusion in the new Block 14 facility at Collins Barracks. Environmental monitoring continued across the Museum's various sites.

Tours of the Conservation Building continued to be a great success, while tours of the new Block 14 Furniture Store commenced in conjunction with curatorial and education staff, and also proved very popular.

## CAOMHANTAS

Déantar déantán a chaomhnú sa chéad áit lena ríocht a chobhsú ionas go gcuirtear ar láimh shábháilte iad don todhchaí. Is trína chinntí go gcoimeádtar gach déantán sa timpeallacht cheart stórála (caomhnú coisctheach) agus trí aon mheath atá cheana ann a aisiompú le hob-air chúramach saotharlainne (caomhnú deisiúcháin) a dhéantar é seo.

D'oscail roinnt taispeántas i rith na bliana, agus bhí ualach mór oibre ag gabháil le cuid diobh don Roinn Caomhantais. Ar na taispeántais seo bhí Influence - Contemporary Metals and Jewellery, Scéalta Bréagáin agus Bóithrin na Smaointe - Óige sna 1950í. Lean an obair ar an taispeántas Stair Mhileata.

Ba é an tionscadal 'Cad atá sa Stór?' an tionscadal ba mhó ar fad ar tugadh faoi in 2004. I gceist sa tionscadal seo bhí glanadh a dhéanamh ar 12,000 déantán ó na bailiúcháin Ealaíon agus Tionscal. Bhí na bailiúcháin iomlána miotalóireachta, oirthearracha agus gloine san áireamh anseo. Bhí deacrachtaí ag gabháil le hullmhú na ndéantán i ngeall ar an méid mór salachair a bhí ar na déantán, i ngeall ar iad a bheith stóráilte go dtí sin i lusca na hEalaíon agus Tionscal ag Sráid Chill Dara. San iomlán, caithheadh breis is 6 bliain duine ag ullmhú na ndéantán le cur sa tsaoráid seo.

Tionscadal mór eile ab ea caomhnú na macasamhla pláistair de ardchroiseanna, chun iad a ullmhú le dul ar taispeáint i bPailliún na hÉireann ag Expo 2005, Nagoya, an tSeapáin. Tá drochbhail ar na croiseanna seo atá suas le 6.5m ar airde, i ngeall ar an mbealach neamhoiriúnach a storáladh iad. Rinne dul chun cinn maith sa taighde ar dhá chorpaí portaigh a fritheadh in 2003, mar chuid de Thionscadal Corpán Portaigh an Ard-Mhúsaeim, a d'fhéach leis an oiread eolais agus ab

fhéidir a ghnóthú mar gheall ar shaol agus bás na ndaoine seo. D'fhás an obair seo ina mórtionscadal taighde idirnáisiúnta i gcomhar leis an BBC a choinnigh súil ar an dul chun cinn d'fhor clár fainseise a dhéanamh faoi.

Leanadh le tionscadail eile chun uasghrádú córasach á dhéanamh ar bhaillíúcháin iomlána. Leanadh den obair ar na mbaillíúcháin troscáin seanré atá ag cur go mór le ríocht an bhaillíúcháin seo. Ar na bailiúcháin eile a rinneadh an obair sin orthu bhí Gloine Blaschka i Stair an Dúlra, na bailiúcháin Cheirmeacha agus Gloine in Ealaíon agus Tionscal agus an bailiúchán Tuí agus Ciseadóireachta i Roinn Saol Tire Éireann. Leanadh den obair san Ionad Adhmaid Bháite ag Béal Átha Liag chun riarráiste 60 bliain de chaomhnú adhmaid bháite a ghlanadh. Bhí toradh fóntha air seo.

Ba é an tionscadal ba mhó i dtaca le caomhnú coisctheach in 2004 ná aistriú ábhair ón Giomnáisiam ag Dún Uí Choileáin, agus ag stór Inse Chór, chuig an tsaoráid nua ag Bloc 14 de Dhún Uí Choileáin. Ar na déantán a ais-triódh bhí bailiúchán iomlán an troscáin seanré agus mórchuid déantán mór ó áiteanna ar fud an mhúsaem. Glanadh déantán ó Inse Chór go córasach le salachar a chosc ó theacht isteach sa tsaoráid nua. Ghnóthaigh saoráid Bhloc 14 Gradam Mhúsaem na Bliana le haghaidh an Aire is fearr do Bhaillíúchán. ## REGISTRATION

3 6

The Registration Department is responsible for recording museum objects, managing the archives and library in addition to dealing with loans issues.

2004 saw the transfer of the Registration Department, including offices, Library and the Art & Industry Archive, from Clarke Square to Block 10 at Collins Barracks. Block 10 was converted to incorporate customised library, archive and office spaces with lift and ramp to facilitate access to both floors.

Documentation and photography of the collections continued; 15,043 records were created from objects and registers and 25,331 were edited. Staff based at the

Documentation of the following exhibitions has taken place in 2004: *All that Glisters...., Living on the Land*, Michael Collins, *Toy Stories*, *Down Memory Lane - Childhood in the 1950s*, *Neo-Celtic Art* and Jewellery exhibitions at Collins Barracks.

In the Library, all 2004 acquisitions were catalogued. The Art & Industrial Division and Reference Libraries formerly located in Clarke Square were packed and listed prior to transfer to Block 10. 476 new book titles were acquired and catalogued in 2004. 1,000 journals were received and circulated. 10 new journal subscriptions were taken out. A user-friendly front end (OPAC) was developed for the Library System.

### THE TF SERIES OF IRISH FOLK LIFE DIVISION SLIDES WAS SCANNED FOR ATTACHMENT TO A DATABASE CURRENTLY UNDER DEVELOPMENT. 14,000 RECORDS FROM THE NATURAL HISTORY DIVISION REGISTERS WERE OUTSOURCED FOR DATA ENTRY.

National Museum of Ireland - Country Life registered 235 objects acquired by curators in 2004.

Transfer of collections continued: 12,000 objects were moved to facilitate Military History development, the majority of these to 'What's In Store?'. 1,344 objects were transferred from Daingean to Turlough Park House, and 490 objects moved from the Gym to the new furniture store in Block 14 at Collins Barracks.

One third of the Easter Week Collection was repacked to ensure long-term accessibility and conservation needs while 8,971 Ethnographic objects were repacked and stored. The locations of 15,099 objects were checked and updated during 2004, with a further 5254 audited and found to be correct.

In the area of archives, the Bell & Howell database of Microfilm holdings was updated and crosschecked with microfilms from the Irish Folklife Division. The microfilms were scanned. The TF series of Irish Folklife Division slides was scanned for attachment to a database currently under development. 14,000 records from the Natural History Division Registers were outsourced for data entry. 3,990 records were created via outsourcing for addition to the Irish Antiquities Division photographic database.

Inward and outwards loans were processed during the year. Eighty individual objects and one exhibition were taken in on loan in 2004 while four other loans were returned. Eleven outward loans began the year, (four of which were renewals), three finished within the year and a further four longer term loans were concluded.







### CAPITAL PROJECTS

Following approval by the Minister for Arts, Sport and Tourism in 2003 the scheme for the central building at the National Museum of Ireland - Decorative Arts & History, Collins Barracks was lodged with the Planning Department of Dublin City Council at the end of August 2004. Planning permission was received in October. The Central Block development will provide greatly improved public services as well as significant new exhibition spaces and is a key priority for the Museum in establishing its vision for the Collins Barracks campus.

In March a contractor was appointed to the restoration project on the Riding School, Collins Barracks, this work is scheduled for completion in January 2005. The Riding School, encompassing 450 square metres of space, will be a major addition to the gallery capacity of the Museum at Collins Barracks. It will be used for the display of major temporary exhibitions on a variety of Museum themes.

Planning permission was secured for the building works to the North Block of Clarke Square, Collins Barracks and for the new build at the rear of the North Block which

and Tourism in November. This innovative project has allowed the Museum to put on public view over 12,000 artefacts most of which have never before been on public display.

At the National Museum of Ireland - Archaeology & History, Kildare St the OPW commissioned a consultant to carry out a development control plan for the Museum building on Kildare Street. The plan will provide a detailed blue print for the future development of the building and will address issues such as disabled access, better public reception and toilet facilities, a more coherent visitor experience and the provision of a lecture theatre and a temporary gallery space. The Development Plan will be finalised in 2005.

At the National Museum of Ireland - Natural History, Merrion St the OPW commissioned Paul Quilligan, Architects, to carry out a building development plan for the Natural History Building on Merrion Street. The main focus of the plan will address access and the provision of improved public and education facilities. Initial meetings took place

will facilitate the exhibition of large military objects as part of the forthcoming Military History exhibition. The sketch scheme for this exhibition design was presented by the OPW to the Museum in September and the project is due for completion in mid 2006.

The building works for 'What's in Store?' was completed in October and launched by the Minister for Arts, Sport

with the OPW and a brief of requirements was drawn up by the Museum to inform the development plan. Work on the Development plan will be completed in 2005.

At the National Museum of Ireland - Country Life, Turlough Park the work to the courtyard area of Turlough Park House was completed giving additional education space and a much needed extension to the café operation.

### EDUCATION AND OUTREACH

In 2004 the Department in 2004 combined the day-to-day management of the Education and Outreach programme with the ongoing review of the role of the Department within the Museum. The Education and Outreach Officers continued to work on the Museum's Education Policy Document, while a consultant was engaged to evaluate the informal education programme at the four Museum sites. This report will be presented in 2005.

The Education and Outreach Officers continued to work with other Cultural Institutions through their membership of the Education and Community Outreach Working Group of the Council of National Cultural Institutions. In April the Minister for Arts, Sport and Tourism, Mr John O'Donoghue T.D., launched their document *A Policy Framework for Education, Community Outreach*, which will inform the future course of these programmes in the Institutions involved.

The Department continued to initiate and deliver a comprehensive programme directed at both the formal and informal education sectors. Guided tours, seminars and In Service Courses were delivered to the formal education sector, family tours, vacation workshops and calendar related events were also offered to provide many different types of experiences to visitors. Ongoing programmes such as participation in *Seachtain na Gaeilge* and *Heritage Week* continued as well as Summer Schools which introduce children to the exhibitions through creative learning.

An exhibition was mounted at the National Museum of Ireland - Country Life inspired by the 2003 summer building project. The 2004 summer building project saw the construction of a block wheel cart. During *Heritage Week* the Department invited communities in Mayo to represent their local heritage in a special exhibition '*Mo Cheanatar Fein*'.

The Wednesday lunchtime lecture series at the National Museum of Ireland - Archaeology & History celebrated its twentieth anniversary with a special series in the

Spring. A two-day seminar was organised on the involvement of Irishmen and women in the First World War at the National Museum of Ireland - Decorative Arts & History. It is planned to publish the proceedings of the seminar in 2005.

The Department's outreach work continued with staff presenting workshops at a number of venues including schools, libraries and community centres. The joint programme with the St John of God Carmona Services resulted in an exhibition of the participants work at the National Museum of Ireland - Archaeology & History. At the National Museum of Ireland - Country Life collaborative work with adult clients of the NTDI Fresh Start initiative led to an exhibition in August, while a garden trail resulted from work carried out with young adults with learning difficulties. Involvement with the Heritage Service of Offaly County Council in devising a heritage tour of the archaeological exhibitions brought a large number of school and adult groups to the Museum.

The Education and Outreach Officers represented visitor needs on long and short-term exhibition teams and worked with curatorial staff in developing exhibition related programmes. The Department also worked with the staff of the Marketing Department in facilitating programmes connected with corporate events.

In addition to accommodating second level work experience students the Department also facilitated internships including two under the European Leonardo Da Vinci programme.

At the National Museum of Ireland - Country Life major work was carried out on the development and piloting of a computerised booking system. The Department received a grant from a charitable foundation involved in educational projects for young people. The grant was awarded to develop the Museum's Handling Collection and ways of using the collection with 8 - 16 year olds. A consultant will be appointed in 2005 to co-ordinate the project, which will be steered by the NMI Handling Committee.

*Bhí na hOifigigh Oideachais agus For-rochtana ag obair i gcónai le hInstitiúidi Cultúrtha tríd a gcomhaltacht ar an nGrúpa Oibre For-rochtana Oideachais agus Pobail de chuid Chomhairle na nInstitiúidi Náisiúnta Cultúrtha. In Aibreán sheol an tAire Ealaíon, Spórt agus Turasóireachta, John O'Donoghue, T.D., a ndoiciméad A Policy Framework for Education, Community Outreach, a mbeidh tionchar aige ar na cláir seo feasta sna hinsitítiúidí lena mbaineann.*

*Choimeád an Roinn uirthi ag cur clár uileghabhálach saindeartha ar fáil a bhí dirithe ar na hearnálach oideachais, idir fhoirmiúil agus neamhfhoirmiúil. Cuirteadh turais threoraithe, seimineáir agus cúrsai inseirbhise ar fáil don earnáil oideachais fhoirmiúil agus ina theannta sin tairgeadh turais teaghlaigh, ceardlanna saoire agus imeachtaí a bhí bainteach leis an bhféilire chun éispéisí dhifriúla a sholáthar do chuaireoirí. Chláir leantacha ar nós rannpháirtíocht i Seachtain na Gaeilge agus Seachtain na hOidhreachta agus eagrú Scoileanna Samhraídha a thugann buneolas do pháistí ar na taispeántais trí fhoghlaím chruthaitheach.*

Mar thoradh ar an gcomhchlár le Seirbhís Carmona Naomh Eoin Dé gléasadh taispeántas de obair na rannpháirtithe ag Ard-Mhúsaem na hÉireann - Seandálaíocht & Stair. Ag Ard-Mhúsaem na hÉireann - Saol na Tuaithe ritheadh taispeántas i mí Lúnasa de obair a rinneadh i gcomhar le haosaigh ó thionscnamh Tús Úr de chuid NTDI, agus rinneadh conair gairdín mar thoradh ar obair a rinneadh le haosaigh óga a bhfuil deacrachtai foghlama acu. **MARKETING**

The Marketing activity at the National Museum of Ireland was extensive during 2004. Marketing and promotion of exhibitions, events and activities was undertaken at all sites, including formal openings, advertising, media coverage, promotional campaigns involving the preparation of literature and other promotional activities.

The following is a breakdown of visitor numbers at all four sites.

A new look calendar of events was produced for the April to June quarterly edition. Feedback on the new layout was positive and the July - September and October - December quarterly Calendars were produced in this format.

*Brand Identity Guidelines* for the National Museum were developed and distributed. A new generic four-sited Museum brochure using the new brand identity was developed and widely distributed to target audiences. A major signage project was carried out by the Marketing Department at the Museum's three Dublin sites. Visibility, access and way finding for visitors at the sites improved considerably as a result.

The Luas 'Red line' connecting Tallaght and Connolly Station, with a designated Museum stop at Collins Barracks, was launched in September. The Museum celebrated

with a wide range of marketing activity resulting in a lot of favourable PR coverage. It is expected that the LUAS will facilitate a major increase of visitors to the Collins Barracks site.

A national radio advertising campaign was undertaken promoting the National Museum as a four sited Institution. This campaign was supported and added to by outdoor advertising and print advertising in a number of specialist magazines and on 100,000 UK/Europe air ticket wallets.

The Department facilitated a National Appeal for artefacts for the Military History exhibition. The appeal was very successful and a number of artefacts were secured as a result. During May audience research was carried out the results of which will be a key informant in the design of the new galleries.

2004 was as a set up year for Corporate Services at the Museum. Many of the core requirements such as furniture, equipment, fittings, organisation, marketing, sales etc. were addressed. Much was also achieved in terms of brand awareness in the various target markets. While 2004 was a set up year a wide range of events took place from intimate meetings for small associations to large-scale book launches, award ceremonies, fashion events, etc. The added value of these events was that the attendees at these corporate events were exposed to the Museum, many for the first time. The PR and press coverage was also extremely valuable for the National Museum.

In 2004 a turnover figure of €720K was achieved across all sites, an increase of 12% on 2003. Sales per visitor and per customer increased overall. New product development continued with increases to the book, giftware and stationery ranges.

Cuireadh féilire nua imeachtaí i dtoll a chéil don eagrán ceathrúnach ó Aibreán go Meitheamh. Fuarthas aiseolas dearfach i dtaoibh an leagan amach nua agus foilsiodh na feáilí ceathrúnacha do lúil - Meán Fómhair agus Deireadh Fómhair - Nollaig sa bhformáid seo.

Cuireadh treoirínte maidir le Féiniúlacht Bhranda i dtoll a chéile agus dáileadh iad. Cuireadh bróisiúr nua cinéalach do cheithre láthair an mhúsaem i dtoll a chéile faoin mbranda nua agus dáileadh é go forleathan ar lucht féachana féidearthá. gaíochta chun stad an Luais a cheiliúradh agus fuarthas dea-thuairiscí sna meáin. Tá súil go dtiocfaidh fás móra ar lion na gcuaireoirí ag Dún Uí Choileáin mar thoradh ar an Luas.

Tugadh faoi fheachtas fógraiochta náisiúnta raidió chun an Músaem a chur chun cinn mar institiúid ar cheithre láthair. Baineadh úsáid as fograiocht lasmuigh agus fógraiocht phríonta i roinnt sainirisí agus ar 100,000 fillteán aerthícéad RA/Eorpach mar chuid den fheachtas seo.

D'éascaigh an Roinn Achainí Náisiúnta do dhéantáin don taispeántas Stair Mhileata. Bhí rath ar an achainí agus fuarthas roinnt mhaith déantán dá bharr. Le linn mhí na Bealtaine tugadh faoi thaighde ar lucht féachana agus beidh an-tionchar aige seo ar dhearadh na ngáilearaithe nua.

Ba é 2004 túsbhliain na Seirbhísí Corparáideacha ag an Músaem. Chuathas i gceann mórchuid de na príomhriachtanais dála troscán, trealamh, feistis, eagraiocht, margaocht, diolacháin etc.. Rinneadh an-dul chun cinn maidir le feasacht bhranda sna spriocmhargai éagsúla. Ba é 2004 an bhliain tosaigh ach fós féin ritheadh raon leathan imeachtaí sa raon ó dhlílthchrúinnithe do chumainn bheaga go seoláit leabhair ar an mórchóir, searmanais dámhachtana, imeachtaí faisín, etc. Ba é breisluach na n-imeachtaí seo ná gur taispeánadh an Músaem don dream a d'fhreastail ar na himeachtaí seo, agus ba é an chéad uair i gcás uimhir mhór daoibh. Bhí an clúdach Caidreamh Poiblí agus an clúdach sna meáin fíorluachmhar don Mhúsaem.

Sroicheadh figiúr láimhdeachais de €720K in 2004 ar fud na láithreacha go léir; ar mheádú é de 12% ar 2003. Mhéadaigh diolacháin in aghaidh an chuaireora agus in aghaidh an chustaiméara san ionlán. Leanadh de tháirí nua a fhorbairt agus cuireadh le raon na leabhar, na n-earraí bronntanais agus an pháipearachais.

## PHOTOGRAPHY

The Department provides a photographic service to all areas of the Museum producing images of museum objects for in-house use and for external clients. Museum publications, promotional literature, new archaeological discoveries and lectures all require photographic images.

The photography for the Military History exhibition began at the end of August and was ongoing at the end of 2004. Over 400 images were taken of objects until the end of the year. As well as the Military History exhibition photographic support was provided for the Currach exhibition, Slovene Ethnographic Museum, Ljubljana and *Toy Stories* at the National Museum of Ireland - Decorative Arts & History. Photography was organised from a panel of PR Photographers and carried out at all major marketing events and educational activities at all sites throughout the year.

Ongoing requests for the external market were carried out as well as general requests for all Divisions and Departments for research and publication projects

including the calendar of events and 2000-2002 Museum Report.

Specialised training in Digital Photography Workflow began at the end of August and was completed in early November. Research with similar institutions in Ireland and the UK in order to benchmark the National Museum of Ireland's Photographic and Rights & Reproductions Service was undertaken. This was carried out in conjunction with the Rights & Reproductions Committee in order to formulate a new strategy for photographic rights & reproductions.

A contract for service was sanctioned for six months to carry out some of the projects during the year and a third level student was also facilitated.

The transition to digital photography was facilitated with the purchase of digital equipment for the Photographic Department as well as the purchase of several digital cameras for Conservation, Education and Outreach and the Curatorial Divisions.

## GRIANGHRAFACHT

Cuireann an Roinn seo seirbhís ghrianghrafadóireachta ar fáil do gach cuid den Mhúsaem agus táirgeonn iomhána de dhéantán an mhúseaim le haghaidh úsáid intí agus do chliaint sheachtracha. Tugadh faoi thaighde le hinstítiúidí comhchosúla in Éirinn agus sa RA d'fhoinn tagarmharcáil a dhéanamh ar Sheirbhís Ghrianghrafadóireachta agus Cearta & Atáirgí Ard-Mhúsaem na hÉireann. Rinneadh é seo i gcomhar leis an gCoiste Cearta & Atáirgí d'fhoinn straitéis nua a cheapadh do chearta & atáirgí grianghrafadóireachta.

Ceadaíodh conradh seirbhise do shé mhí d'fhoinn roinnt de na tionscadail a chur i gcrích i rith na bliana agus fostáiodh mac léinn tríu leibhéal chomh maith.

Éascaíodh an t-aistriú go grianghradaradóireacht dhigiteach nuair a ceannaíodh trealamh digiteach don Roinn Grianghrafadóireachta chomh maith le roinnt ceamarai digiteacha do na Ranna Caomhantais, Oideachais agus For-rochtain agus Coimeádta.

### DESIGN

The Design Department provides a quality design service to all Departments and Divisions within the Museum. This includes the design of in-house posters, brochures, exhibition panels, archaeological illustrations (including the provision of maps and site plans) as well as support for exhibitions and lectures.

In tandem with the Education Department, Kildare Street the Department designed and mounted an exhibition of children's artwork held as part of the programme for Heritage week. In addition to mounting the exhibition, certificates, catalogue, and exhibition poster were also designed and printed.

Exhibition support was provided for a number of temporary exhibitions including *Inspirational Awakening - Irish Contemporary Glass*; *Influence - Contemporary Metals and Jewellery* and *Toy Stories*. Illustration work

included drawing artefacts for the unpublished Burials project and work also commenced on the Leather Scabbards and Medieval Pottery as part of the Dublin Excavation Publication Project.

Two educational activity sheets were designed and printed as part of the World Habitats Activity series and work also commenced on the design of a children's colouring book. In addition to this a large quantity of scanning and enhancing of imagery was provided for all the Divisions/ Departments within the Museum.

Graphic panels were designed for a large display case housing ships timbers. The Design department also facilitated a number of students on work experience and transition year programmes. A significant development during the year was the filling of the post of Senior Graphic Artist.

ILLUSTRATION WORK INCLUDED DRAWING ARTEFACTS FOR THE UNPUBLISHED BURIALS PROJECT AND WORK ALSO COMMENCED ON THE LEATHER SCABBARDS AND MEDIEVAL POTTERY AS PART OF THE DUBLIN EXCAVATION PUBLICATION PROJECT.**







## DEARADH

I gcomhar leis an Roinn Oideachais, Sráid Chill Dara dhear agus ghléas an Roinn taispeántas de obair ealaíne páistí mar chuid den gclár do Sheachtain na hOidhreachta. I dtéannta an taispeántas a ghléasadh, dearadh agus prioritáladh roinnt teastas, catalóg, agus póstaer taispeántais.

Cuireadh tacaiocht taispeántais ar fáil do roinnt taispeántas sealadach lena n-áirítear *Inspirational Awakening - Irish Contemporary Glass; Influence - Contemporary Metals and Jewellery* agus Scéalta Bréagáin. Ar an obair

léirithe bhí déantán a tharraingt don tionscadal Adhlacthaí nár foilsíodh go fóill agus cuireadh túis leis an obair ar Scabairdí Leathair agus Potaireacht Meánaoiseach mar chuid de Thogra Foilseachán Thochaití Bhaile Átha Cliath.

### ACCOMMODATION AND SECURITY


The Department in organisational terms falls under the Services Division of the National Museum of Ireland. The Department provides front of house services throughout the four Museum sites. Assisted by a staff of eighty personnel the facilities manager provides an array of services from invigilation to providing a warm and friendly environment for the general public. In addition the facilities manager has responsibility for Security, Health and Safety, Transport, Communications and Utilities.

Great assistance was received from the OPW in the maintenance of our public buildings. With the support and co-operation of Building Management Services the stone restoration projects at the National Museum of

Ireland - Archaeology & History and the National Museum of Ireland - Natural History were completed. Extensive painting was carried out in galleries in both the National Museum of Ireland - Decorative Arts & History and Archaeology & History. Refurbishment took place of the east side of Clarke Square, which included its conversion into the visible storage facility, '*What's in Store?*'.

The Luas project created a high degree of disruption during its construction phase, however the *Luas 'Red Line'* opened to the public in September 2004 and the National Museum of Ireland - Decorative Arts & History is enjoying the fruits of its labour with a designated Museum stop at Collins Barracks.




## ADMINISTRATION

### General

The Administration Division is responsible for the overall administration of the National Museum of Ireland. In 2004, the main areas of responsibility were financial management, human resources management and information technology. In addition the Administration Division worked closely with its parent Department, the Department of Arts, Sport and Tourism in relation to the preparations for autonomous status under the National Cultural Institutions Act of 1997.

### Financial Management

The Museum continued to process payments, monitor and control expenditure, and produce financial reports using its computerised Financial Management System (Renaissance) and the Electronic Point of Sale (EPOS) System for the Museum Shops.

In October, 2004, following a tender competition, HELM Group was awarded a contract for the provision of financial /accounting services to the Museum and, in particular, to support the Financial Management System and provide assistance with putting in place the necessary financial /accounting arrangements for Museum autonomy.

### Current Income and Expenditure

As in previous years, in 2004, finance for the operation of the Museum and for the development of its collections came from a number of different sources:

- i) Salaries, wages and allowances of the permanent staff were paid directly from the Vote of the Department of Arts, Sport and Tourism.
- ii) The administrative costs of postal/phone services and heat/light were met partly from the administra-

tive budget subheads of the Vote of the Department of Arts, Sport and Tourism. The balance was met from the Current allocation received from the Vote of the Department of Arts, Sport and Tourism.

- iii) Other current costs (including other administrative costs) were met from a grant fund provided for in the Vote of the Department of Arts, Sport and Tourism and from financial resources generated by the Museum itself.

### Capital Income and Expenditure

The Commissioners of Public Works are responsible for the provision of services for the construction and maintenance of the buildings occupied by the Museum. The costs involved are met from the Vote for the Office of Public Works. Other Capital costs (e.g. purchase of artefacts/specimens for the collections, IT hardware, exhibition support, etc) in 2004 were met from a Capital allocation to the Museum from the Department's Vote.

See the following table showing the Museum's income and expenditure in respect of the year 2004 (with comparative figures for the year 2003).

### Human Resource Management

In 2004, responsibilities included (in co-operation with the Department of Arts, Sport and Tourism) recruitment, training, co-ordination of the implementation of the Performance Management Development System (PMDS) and general personnel administration.

In line with Sustaining Progress, flexible working hours (Flexi-Time) was extended to include professional/technical staff, and the operating system was changed from a clock-based system to a Personal Computer log-on /log-off system.

### **Information Technology**

In 2004, an IT Manager and a replacement IT Officer were appointed. The following work was carried out:

- The Museum was connected to the Government Data Virtual Private Network (VPN), resulting in a doubling of IT communications bandwidth, an increase in the speed of IT communications and a reduction in networking costs.
- An IT Helpdesk service was introduced and ensured the efficient and smooth operation of IT systems.
- The Museum IT network was extended to include the Beggars Bush storage facility.
- New Personal Computers were installed to complete the upgrading of the IT network from a Windows 98 to a Windows 2000/ XP operating system.
- Mailmarshal (e-mail filtering system), anti-virus and server backup software were upgraded.
- Access was provided to staff to a new Health and Safety database.
- Following an audit of printers and print requirements, stand-alone printers were (where appropriate) replaced with networked printers, thereby improving the reliability of printers/print speed and reducing maintenance costs.
- A programme of IT training for staff, provided by an external training company and catering for different ability levels and requirements, was arranged by the IT Department.

### **Irish EU Presidency Meeting and Conference**

A very successful meeting and conference of the National

Representatives Group for Digitisation of Heritage and Culture was hosted in Dublin in June 2004, as part of the Irish EU Presidency programme. The National Museum hosted the opening and closing receptions. A number of staff from the Museum attended the conference. As part of the conference proceedings, the Museum put together a conference poster outlining the ongoing work on the use of 3-D imaging in the Museum.

The organisational arrangements for the meeting and conference were looked after by the Head of Administration (with the assistance of Administration Division staff) and An Chomhairle Leabharlanna (the Irish Library Council).

### **Museum Autonomy**

The National Cultural Institutions Act, 1997, provides for the establishment of the Museum as an independent statutory body.

During 2004, further meetings and discussions were held with the Department of Arts, Sport and Tourism to make preparations for autonomy and, in particular, to agree and secure the necessary additional resources (staffing, systems and finances) to undertake the administrative functions (mainly financial and human resources) transferring to the Museum from the Department. The Head of Administration continued to represent the Museum on the autonomy implementation committee set up by the Department.

Discussions and meetings were also held with staff unions, and information/briefing sessions for staff (at which Museum senior management and representatives of the Department of Arts, Sport and Tourism briefed staff on autonomy and answered questions) were held.

By the end of 2004, significant progress had been made on preparations for autonomy but, to allow further time to finalise preparations, autonomy was deferred to 2005 by the Minister for Arts, Sport and Tourism, John O'Donoghue T.D.

## RIARACHÁN

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### Ginearálta

Tá cúram ar an Rannóg Riaracháin as riarchán foriomlán Ard-Mhúsaem na hÉireann. In 2004, ba iad na priomhréimsí cúraim ná bainistiocht airgeadais, bainistiocht acmhainní daonna agus teicneolaiocht an eolaíos. Lena chois sin d'oibrigh an Rannóg Riaracháin go dlúth lena mháthair-roinn, an Roinn Ealaón, Spóirt agus Turasóireachta i dtaca le hullmhúcháin do stádas uathrialach faoi Acht na nInstitiúidí Cultúrtha Náisiúnta 1997.

### Bainistiocht Airgeadúil

Choinnigh an Mhúsaem air ag próiseáil íocaiochtaí, ag coimeád súil ar chaiteachas agus á rialú, agus ag soláthar tuairisci airgeadais ag baint úsáid as an gCóras Bainistiochta Airgeadais (Renaissance) agus an Córás Dilphonte Leictreonaigh do shiopai an Mhúsaem.

In Deireadh Fómhair 2004, tar éis comórtas tairiscintí, bronnadh conradh ar HELM Group as seirbhísí airgeadais /cuntasaiochta a sholáthar don Mhúsaem, agus go háirithe, chun tacú leis an gCóras Bainistiochta Airgeadais agus cúnamh a thabhairt nuair a bheidh na socruithe riachtanacha airgeadais/cuntasaiochta á gcur i bhfeidhm do uathriail an Mhúsaem.

### Ioncam agus Caiteachas Reatha

Mar ab amhlaidh i mblianta roimhe seo, in 2004 tháinig airgead le haghaidh oibriú an mhúsaem agus d'fhobairt a bhailiúcháin ó fhoinsí éagsúla:

i) Íocadh tuarastail, pá agus liúntais na foirne buan go direach as Vóta na Roinne Ealaón, Spóirt agus Turasóireachta.

ii) Íocadh costas riarchán seirbhísí poist/fóin agus

teasa/solais roinnt ó fhomhírcinn bhuiséad riarchán Vóta na Roinne Ealaón, Spóirt agus Turasóireachta. Íocadh an fuilleach ón gcionroinnt reatha a fuarthas ó Vóta na Roinne Ealaón, Spóirt agus Turasóireachta.

iii) Íocadh costais reatha eile (lena n-áirítear costais riarchán eile) ó chiste deontais a ndéantar soláthar ina leith i Vóta na Roinne Ealaón, Spóirt agus Turasóireachta agus ó acmhainní airgeadúla a ghineann an Mhúsaem féin.

### Ioncam agus Caiteachas Caipiteal

Is ar Choimisinéirí na nOibreacha Poiblí atá an cúram seirbhísí a sholáthar le haghaidh tógáil agus cothabháil na bhfoirgneamh ina bhfuil an tArd-Mhúseam suite. Íocatar na costais a bhíonn i gceist as Vóta Oifig na nOibreacha Poiblí. Íocadh costais chaipítíúla eile (m.sh. déantáin/eiseamail a cheannach do na bailiúcháin, crua-earraí FE, tacafocht taispeántais, srl.) ó chionroinnt chaipítíodon Mhúsaem a thagann as Vóta na Roinne.

Féach an tábla seo a leanas a thaispeánann ioncam agus caiteachas an Mhúsaem don bhliain 2004 (le figiúirí comparáideacha don bhliain 2003).

### Bainistiocht Acmhainní Daonna

In 2004, d'fholáigh na freagrachtaí (i gcomhar leis an Roinn Ealaón, Spóirt agus Turasóireachta) earcú, oiliúint, comhordú fheidhmiú an Chórais Forbartha um Bainistiocht Feidhmíochta agus riarchán ginearálta pearsanra.

De réir 'An Dul Chun Cinn a Choimeád', leathnaíodh na fleisc-uaireanta oibre (Fleisc-am) go dtí an fhoireann ghairmiúil/theicniúil, agus athraíodh an córas oibriochta ó chóras clogbhunaithe go córas logáil isteach/logáil amach ar Riomhaire Pearsanta.

### **Teicneolaíocht Faisnéise**

In 2004, ceapadh Bainisteoir TF agus Oifigeach TF athsholáthair. Cuireadh an obair seo a leanas i gcrích:

- Ceanglaodh an múaem le Lionra Priobháideach Fiorúil Shonrai an Rialtais (VPN), as a lean dúbait den bhandaleithead cumarsáide TF, méadú i luas cumarsáidi TF agus laghdú i gcostais lionraiochta.
- Tugadh seirbhís deisc chabhraigh TF isteach a chinn-tigh gur oibrigh córais TF go héifeachtach agus go réidh.
- Leathnaiodh lionra TF an mhúsaeim go saoráid stórála Tor an Bhacainn a chur san áireamh.
- Suiteáladh riomhairí pearsanta nua chun uasghrádú na lionraiocht TF a chríochnú ó chóras oibriochta Windows 98 go córas Window 2000/XP.
- Tugadh bogearraí mailmarshal (córás scagaire riomh-phoist), frithvís agus freastalaí cíltaca cothrom le dáta.
- Cuireadh rochtain ar fáil don fhoireann ar bhunachar sonrai nua Sláinte agus Sábhálteachta.
- Théis iniúchadh ar phrintéiri agus riachtanais phriontála, ceannaídh printéiri lionraithe in áit na bprintéiri neamhspleácha (nuair ab ionchúi), ionas gur cuireadh le hiontaofacht printéiri/luas prioritála agus gur laghdáodh costais chothabhlá.
- Shocraigh an Roinn TF clár oiliúna TF don fhoireann a cuireadh ar fáil ag cuideachta oiliúna seachtrach a d'fhreastail ar leibhéal éagsúla cumais agus riachtanais éagsúla.

### **Cruinniú agus Comhdháil Uachtaráinacht na hÉireann ar an Aontas Eorpach**

Óstaiodh cruinniú agus comhdháil rathúil de Ghrúpa Iondaithe Náisiúnta do Dhigitíu na hOidhreachta agus

an Chultúir i mBaile Átha Cliath i Meitheamh 2004, mar chuid de chlár na nÉireann le linn Uachtaráinacht an Aontais Eorpach. D'óstáil Ard-Mhúsaem na hÉireann na hócáidí oscailte agus dúnta. Bhí comhaltaí d'fhoireann an mhúsaeim i láthair ag an gcomhdháil. Mar chuid d'imeachtaí na comhdhála, chuir an múaem póstaer comhdhála i dtoll a chéile a thug sracfhéachaint ar obair leantach an mhúsaeim ar úsáid iomhána 3-D sa Mhúsaem.

Ba é an Ceannasaí Riaracháin (le cabhair ó fhoireann na Roinne Riaracháin) agus An Chomhairle Leabharlanna a bhí i mbun na socrutha eagrúcháin don gcuirinní agus don gcomhdháil.

### **Féinriail an Mhúsaeim**

Déantar soláthar in Acht na nInstitiúidí Cultúrtha Náisiúnta, 1997, le haghaidh bhunú an Mhúsaeim mar fhoras reachtíul neamhspleách.

I gcaitheamh 2004, reáchtáladh cruinnithe agus diospóireachtaí breise leis an Roinn Ealaíon, Spóirt agus Turasóireachta chun ullmhúcháin a dhéanamh do uathrial agus go háirithe chun na hacmhainní breise a aontú agus a dhaingniú (lón foirne, córais agus airgeadas) a bheidh riachtanach chun tabhairt faoi na feidhmeanna riaracháin (acmhainní airgeadais agus daonna go príomha) a bheidh á n-aistriú go dtí an múaem ón Roinn. Ba é an Ceannasaí Riaracháin a rinne ionadaíocht ar son an mhúsaeim ar choiste feidhmithe uathrialach a chuir an Roinn ar bun.

Bhí cruinnithe agus diospóireachtaí ann le comharchumainn foirne agus seisiún eolais/mionteagaisc don fhoireann (ag a thug bainistíocht shinsearach an Mhúsaeim agus ionadaithe ón Roinn Ealaíon, Spóirt agus Turasóireachta achoimre ar uathrial agus d'fhreagair siad ceisteanna).

Faoi dheireadh 2004, bhí dul chun cinn suntasach déanta i leith ullmhúcháin le haghadh uathrialach, ach chun tuilleadh ama a sholáthar leis na hullmhúcháin a thabhairt chun críche, cuireadh feidhmíú na huathrialach siar go dtí 2005 ag an Aire Ealaíon, Spóirt agus Turasóireachta, John O'Donoghue T.D.

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
